AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POSITION OF CHIEF OF DETECTIVES IN THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section six of chapter twenty-two of the General
2 Laws, as appearing in the Tercentenary Edition, is
3 hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the
4 following:— Detectives appointed by the commis-
5 sioner hereunder shall perform their duties in the
6 division of state police under the direction and super-
7 vision of a chief of detectives who shall be subject
8 to the provisions of chapter thirty-one and who
9 shall be appointed from among the detective inspec-
10 tors and detectives of the division of state police after
11 competitive examination in accordance with civil
12 service rules. Detectives assigned to the division of
13 fire prevention shall perform their duties under the
14 direction and supervision of a state police detective
15 inspector detailed as assistant to the state fire marshal.
