
By Mr. Bullock, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1168) of John W. Bullock for legislation to modify the law respecting the adjustment of pensions of persons gainfully employed after retirement for disability. Public Service.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

AN ACT MODIFYING THE LAW RESPECTING THE ADJUSTMENT OF PENSIONS OF PERSONS GAINFULLY EMPLOYED AFTER RETIREMENT FOR DISABILITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section ninety-one A of chapter thirty-two of the
2 general laws is hereby amended by striking out the second
3 sentence and inserting in place thereof the following: "If such
4 earnings exceed or when added to his adjusted pension or re-
5 tirement allowance in such preceding year exceed, the amount
6 of regular compensation which would have been payable to
7 such person in such preceding year had he continued in serv-
8 ice in the grade held by him at the time he was pensioned or
9 retired, increased by the cost of living index of the United
10 States Department of Labor for the period from the time of
11 retirement to the time of filing the statement, he shall refund
12 his adjusted pension or retirement allowance for such pre-
13 ceding year or a portion thereof equal to such excess, as the
14 case may be; and until such refund is made, his pension or re-
15 tirement allowance shall be withheld as security therefor."

1 SECTION 2. This act shall have effect with respect to all per-
2 sons whose pensions were affected by chapter six hundred
3 eighty-four of the acts of nineteen hundred fifty-eight.
