

HOUSE No. 2105

By Mr. Dickie of Reading, petition of George W. Buck and others (selectmen) for legislation to authorize George W. Buck of Wilmington to become a member of the contributory retirement system of said town. Pensions and Old Age Assistance.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING GEORGE W. BUCK, TAX COLLECTOR OF THE TOWN OF WILMINGTON, TO BECOME A MEMBER OF THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEM OF SAID TOWN, AND MAKING HIM ELIGIBLE FOR CERTAIN RETIREMENT BENEFITS THEREUNDER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. George W. Buck, tax collector of the
2 town of Wilmington, may become a member of the
3 contributory retirement system of said town, notwith-
4 standing any provision of law governing said retire-
5 ment system that makes him ineligible for membership
6 therein. Upon becoming such member, he shall be
7 entitled to all the rights and privileges of members of
8 said system which he would have enjoyed if he had
9 become a member of the system on the date when said
10 system became operative to said town; provided,
11 that he first deposits in the annuity fund of said system
12 such amount as the board of retirement under said

13 system may determine in order to establish an account
14 for him in said annuity fund in an amount equal to that
15 which it would be if he had been a member of said
16 system since said date.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take full effect upon its
2 acceptance by vote of a majority of the voters of the
3 town of Wilmington voting thereon at a town meeting,
4 but not otherwise.
