[Bill accompanying the petition of Charles Williamson. Liquor Law.]

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Ninety-eight.

AN ACT

To repeal the Act of the Year Eighteen Hundred and Ninety-Seven relative to the Transportation of Spirituous and Intoxicating Liquors into No-License Cities and Towns.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter two hundred and seventy-one of
2 the acts of the year eighteen hundred and ninety-seven,
3 being "an act to further regulate the transportation of
4 spirituous and intoxicating liquors into no-license cities
5 and towns," is hereby repealed.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
