An Act requiring the Labelling of Taps used for the Sale
of Malt Beverages on Draught.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section twelve of chapter one hundred and thirty-
- 2 eight of the General Laws, as amended, is hereby fur-
- 3 ther amended by adding at the end the following: —
- 4 No malt beverage shall be sold on draught from a
- 5 tap, faucet or other draughting device unless such de-
- 6 vice is labelled in legible letters with the brand or trade
- 7 name of the malt beverage so sold therefrom.
