AN ACT

In relation to the Payment of Mileage to Members of the
Legislature.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The mileage payable to members of the
2 senate and house of representatives shall be paid on
3 the first day of the next month after the commence-
4 ment of the session.

1 SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with
2 the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.
