## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Sixty-Eight.

AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE PRACTICE OF ELECTROLYSIS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 112 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 striking out section 87FFF, inserted by section 2 of chapter  
3 625 of the acts of 1958, and inserting in place thereof the follow-  
4 ing section: —

5 *Section 87FFF.* No person shall engage in the practice of  
6 electrolysis or hold himself out as a practitioner of, or being  
7 able to practice, electrolysis unless he is duly licensed by the  
8 board, or qualified physician registered under the laws of the  
9 commonwealth; provided, however, this chapter shall not ap-  
10 ply to services rendered by the laws of the commonwealth,  
11 employed by a state, county or municipal institution adminis-  
12 tering such electrolysis treatments to inmates of the employing  
13 institutions, provided further such services are administered  
14 under the supervision and direction of the superintending  
15 physicians of said institution. Whoever violates any provision  
16 of this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than  
17 one hundred dollars.
