AN ACT TO ENABLE THE OFFICE OF CHILDREN TO ESTABLISH DAY CARE CENTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 This Act would enable the State Office of Children to
- 2 establish, fund, and operate day care centers for low and
- 3 moderate income families in need of said facilities.
