AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN EMPLOYES OF THE PAROLE BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Parole Officers and Parole Supervisors of the Parole Board shall
2 be reimbursed for the cost of a ten thousand dollar medical cover-
3 age policy and for the difference in the costs between a fifty thou-
4 sand dollar/one hundred thousand dollar bodily injury policy and
5 a one hundred thousand dollar/three hundred thousand dollar
6 bodily injury policy on their personal cars used for Parole Board
7 business.
