To accompany the petition of Charles W. Olson and Clarence F. Telford for legislation relative to the registration of trailer coaches. Highways and Motor Vehicles.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRATION OF TRAILER COACHES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 90 of the General
2 Laws, as amended, is hereby further amended by
3 inserting after the definition of "Trailer", as appearing
4 in section 2 of chapter 354 of the acts of 1939, the
5 following definition:— "Trailer coach", a trailer
6 designed as a portable housing unit to permit the
7 occupancy thereof for dwelling or sleeping purposes
8 of one or more persons.

1 SECTION 2. The sixth paragraph of section 33 of
2 said chapter 90 is hereby amended by inserting after
3 subdivision (5) the following subdivision:—

4 (5a) For the registration of every trailer coach
5 by an owner, otherwise than a manufacturer of or
6 dealer in, trailer coaches, ten dollars, to be collected

7 by the commissioner of corporations and taxation on
8 behalf of the commonwealth.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect on January
2 first, nineteen hundred and fifty-one.
