AN ACT RELATIVE TO MAKE UP PAYMENTS IN THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEM BY WIDOWS OF CERTAIN FORMER MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL COURT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Upon the payment into the annuity savings fund of the state
2 retirement system of an amount equal to the deductions which
3 would have been normally made from the regular annual com-
4 pensation of any former member of the general court had he
5 become a member of the state retirement system at the time of
6 his entry into the state service together with accumulated in-
7 terest to the date of such payment, the state retirement board
8 shall, notwithstanding any general or special law to the con-
9 trary, pay to the widow of such a member the stipulated yearly
10 allowance for survivors to be determined in accordance with the
11 provisions of sections one to twenty-eight, inclusive, of chapter
12 thirty-two of the General Laws. The allowance payable to such
13 a widow under this act shall terminate upon her remarriage or
14 death.
