### AN ACT

To authorize the Boston, Clinton, Fitchburg, and New-Bedford Railroad Company to discontinue its Passenger-Station in New Bedford.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The Boston, Clinton, Fitchburg, and New-Bedford
- 2 Railroad Company is authorized to discontinue its
- 3 passenger-station on Pearl Street in New Bedford,
- 4 and to provide other depot-accommodations in such
- 5 place or places in said city as may be approved by
- 6 the board of railroad commissioners and the city
- 7 council of the city of New Bedford.
