AN ACT REQUIRING BLINKING OR FLASHING LIGHTS TO BE DISPLAYED ON TRUCKS WHEN BEING OPERATED AT CERTAIN SPEEDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 7L the following section:—
- 3 *Section 7M.* No person shall operate a truck at a speed of
- 4 forty miles per hour or less unless said truck shall have two
- 5 blinking or flashing lights displayed on the front and two
- 6 blinking or flashing lights displayed on the rear of said
- 7 vehicle.
