AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE SITTINGS OF THE SUPERIOR COURT IN THE SEVERAL COUNTIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 212 of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by striking out section 14, as most recently amended
3 by section 1 of chapter 144 of the acts of 1932, and inserting
4 in place thereof the following section:—
5 *Section 14.* A regular sitting or regular sittings of the
6 court in the several counties shall be held in each year in such
7 cities and towns as may be designated by the chief justice of
8 the superior court.

1 SECTION 2. Section 14A of said chapter 212 inserted by
2 section 2 of said chapter 144 of the acts of 1932, is hereby
3 further amended by striking out, in lines 5 and 6, the words
4 “each of the places named in section fourteen of this chapter”,
5 and inserting in place thereof the words:—each of said cities
6 and towns.
