## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifteen.

### AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Suppression of the  
Gypsy and Brown Tail Moths.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sum of one hundred and seventy-  
2 five thousand dollars is hereby appropriated, to be  
3 paid out of the treasury of the commonwealth, from  
4 the ordinary revenue, for the suppression of the  
5 gypsy and brown tail moths and for expenses in-  
6 cidental thereto, as authorized by chapter four hun-  
7 dred and fifty-two of the acts of the year nineteen  
8 hundred and nine, the same to be in addition to the  
9 amounts heretofore appropriated for this purpose.  
(Appropriation 1914, \$200,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
