AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TENURE OF OFFICE OF THE CONFIDENTIAL SECRETARY TO THE BOSTON LICENSING BOARD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The incumbent of the office of confidential
2 tial secretary to the Boston licensing board on July first,
3 nineteen hundred and fifty-six, shall have unlimited ten-
4 ure of office and shall not be removed therefrom except
5 in accordance with the provisions of sections forty-three
6 and forty-five of chapter thirty-one of the General Laws.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
