Chap. 87. AN ACT CLARIFYING THE LAW REGULATING INSURANCE CONTRACTS AGAINST LOSSES BY FIRE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Chapter 186 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out section 21, added by section 7 of chapter 446 of the acts of 1978, and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

Section 21. The landlord or lessor of any residential property except owner-occupied dwellings of four units or fewer, shall, upon the written request of any tenant or lawful occupant or of any code or other law enforcement official disclose in writing within fifteen days of such request the name of the company or companies insuring the property against loss or damage by fire and the amount of insurance provided by each company. Whoever violates this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars. A waiver of this section in any lease or other rental agreement shall be void and unenforceable.

Chap. 88. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE PAROLE BOARD.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

The second paragraph of section 4 of chapter 27 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after the word "association", in line 5, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 994 of the acts of 1971, the words:- or his designee.

Chap. 89. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF EASTON TO PAY A CERTAIN UNPAID BILL.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The town of Easton is hereby authorized to pay an unpaid bill in the amount of eighty-eight dollars and thirty-

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six cents to Marciano-Shaw Sporting Goods, Inc., which bill is legally unenforceable against said town.

SECTION 2. No bill shall be approved by the town accountant of said town for payment or paid by the treasurer thereof under authority of this act unless and until a certificate has been signed and filed with said town accountant, stating under the penalties of perjury that the materials or equipment for which said bill has been submitted were ordered by an official or an employee of said town and that such materials and equipment were delivered to and actually received by said town.

SECTION 3. Any person who knowingly files a certificate required by section two, which is false, and who thereby receives payment for materials and equipment which were not received by said town shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than one year or by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars, or both.

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

Chap. 90. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD TO CONVEY CERTAIN EASEMENTS IN PARK LAND TO THE TOWN OF LONGMEADOW.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. The city of Springfield is hereby authorized to grant and convey to the town of Longmeadow without consideration, certain permanent easements, for water supply purposes, in land located in Forest Park and owned and held by said city under the care, custody and control of the board of park commissioners of said city, all said easements, hereinafter stated, to be within that parcel of land located in Springfield, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the northerly line of Forest Glen Road at the easterly corner of Magawiska Road and Forest Glen Road, said point also being described as on the City of Springfield-Town of Longmeadow boundary line, and thence running S 77° 58' 17" E one hundred and 00/100 (100.00) feet along the said northerly line of Forest Glen Road to a point, thence N 12° 01' 43" E thirty-five and 00/100 (35.00) feet to a point, thence N 65° 59' 25" W ninety-one and 2/10 (91.2) feet to a point in the easterly line of Magawiska Road, thence S 23° 21' 43" W fifty-five and 00/100 (55.00) feet along the said easterly line of Magawiska Road to the point of beginning. Said parcel of land containing 0.98 acres.
