AN ACT RELATIVE TO HEARINGS BEFORE THE BOARD OF APPEALS ON MOTOR VEHICLE LIABILITY POLICIES AND BONDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The second paragraph of section 113D of chapter 175 of
2 the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out said
3 paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following para-
4 graph:—

5 The commissioner shall cause the other members of the
6 board to be notified of the complaint and written notice to
7 be given to the parties of the time and place of the hearing
8 thereon, which time shall be not less than ten days from the
9 filing of the complaint, unless the parties agree in writing
10 that the hearing may be held sooner.
