AN ACT ESTABLISHING A COMMITTEE OF PARKS AND SCHOOLS IN THE CITY OF WORCESTER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The city manager of the city of Worcester is hereby authorized
2 and directed to appoint a committee of parks and schools to
3 consist of three members, of whom one shall be appointed for
4 one year, one for two years and one for three years. Thereafter,
5 at the expiration of the term of office, of a member he shall ap-
6 point one person for a term of three years and he shall fill all
7 vacancies for the balance of the unexpired term. The com-
8 mittee shall have jurisdiction over all school grounds and fa-
9 cilities at any time during the day or evening when the said
10 grounds and facilities are not used by the school committee for
11 the education of pupils. The committee shall use the said
12 grounds and facilities for the development of recreation pro-
13 grams for all residents of the city.
