## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Seventy-Five.

RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO THE ESTABLISHMENT AND FINANCING OF A NO-FARE PREPAID TRANSIT SYSTEM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1     *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of three  
2 members of the senate, five members of the house of  
3 representatives, and three persons to be appointed by the  
4 governor, is hereby established for the purpose of making an  
5 investigation and study relative to the establishment and  
6 financing of a no-fare prepaid transit system. Said commission  
7 shall, in the course of its investigation and study, evaluate the  
8 means of funding. Said commission shall make its final report to  
9 the general court on or before the first Wednesday of May,  
10 nineteen hundred and seventy-six.
