AN ACT FURTHER PROTECTING FLOOD PLAINS, SEACOASTS AND OTHER WETLANDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 40 of chapter 131 of the General
2 Laws, as most recently amended by chapter 131 of the acts of 1977,
3 is hereby further amended by inserting after the second sentence
4 the following sentence: — The selectmen, or the mayor as the case
5 may be, may take any action necessary to prevent soil erosion or
6 otherwise necessary to protect the lives and safety of the public.
