AN ACT PROVIDING FOR NOTICE TO CERTAIN OFFICIALS OF CERTAIN CITIES AND TOWNS PRIOR TO SALE OF LANDS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 3 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after section 44B the following section:—
- 3 *Section 44C.* No lands of the commonwealth shall be sold
- 4 unless notice of such intent shall have been given by certified
- 5 mail to the mayor or city manager of a city, or the selectmen
- 6 of a town where such lands are located.
