AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE POWERS OF THE GOVERNMENT LAND BANK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The seventh paragraph of section 40F of Chapter 7 of the
2 General Laws as inserted by chapter 579 of the acts of 1980 is
3 hereby amended by adding after the first sentence the follow-
4 ing sentence: — Such surplus state property shall be trans-
5 ferred to the government land bank pursuant to paragraph
6 (i) of section 1-4 of the appendix to chapter 7 of the General
7 Laws unless a majority of the board of directors of the gov-
8 ernment land bank certify in writing that such property is not
9 needed for the use of said government land bank.
