## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Six.

### AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for an Additional Building  
at the Soldiers' Home in Massachusetts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives  
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the  
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sum of fifty thousand dollars  
2 is hereby appropriated to be paid out of the  
3 treasury of the Commonwealth from the ordinary  
4 revenue for the purpose of constructing and fur-  
5 nishing an additional building at the soldiers'  
6 home in Massachusetts, located at Chelsea, for  
7 hospital purposes, as authorized by chapter  
8 seventy-seven of the resolves of the year nine-  
9 teen hundred and five, the same to be in addition  
10 to any amount heretofore appropriated for the  
11 same purpose.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
