AN ACT LIMITING TAXICAB LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 All cities and towns in the commonwealth shall limit taxicab
- 2 licenses to one for one thousand five hundred persons. Those
- 3 cab permits now in existence shall not be terminated and shall
- 4 remain as properly licensed taxicab vehicles. However, there
- 5 shall be no new permits issued if they are in violation of this
- 6 one per one thousand five hundred persons.

1. All cities and towns in the Commonwealth shall have the right to
2. provide for the care of the poor and the aged in their respective
3. cities and towns in accordance with the provisions of this
4. act and to appropriate money for the purpose of carrying out the
5. provisions of this act.
6. The provisions of this act shall take effect on the first day of
7. January next.
8. The Governor and Council may amend or repeal this act from time to
9. time.
