## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Five

### AN ACT

Making an Appropriation for the Massachusetts State Sanatorium.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The sum of one hundred and five  
2 thousand dollars is hereby appropriated, to be  
3 paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth,  
4 from the ordinary revenue, for care and main-  
5 tenance of patients at the Massachusetts state  
6 sanatorium during the year ending on the thirty-  
7 first day of December, nineteen hundred and five,  
8 to include printing and binding the annual report;  
9 this amount to be in addition to any receipts that  
10 may be received, and so much of said receipts as  
11 may be needed to pay the expenses of said insti-  
12 tution may be used for that purpose. [Rev.  
13 Laws, chap. 87, sects. 127 and 128.]

(Appropriation 1904, \$90,000.)

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
