1 *Ordered*, That the committee on Local Affairs be authorized
2 to sit during the recess of the general court for the purpose of
3 making an investigation and study of the subject matter of
4 current house document numbered 1570, relative to the control
5 of rents and evictions in certain cities and towns.

6 Said committee shall be provided with quarters in the state
7 house or elsewhere, may hold hearings, may travel within the
8 commonwealth, and may expend for clerical and other services
9 and expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said
10 committee shall report to the general court the results of its
11 investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
12 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such
13 recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk of
14 the House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday in
15 December, nineteen hundred and seventy-two.
