6. In the city of Fitchburg, approximately four tenths of an acre on the north side of the Fifth Massachusetts Turnpike and east of Rollstone Road owned by the city of Leominster and used for the protection of Water Resources to be used for the relocation of the Fifth Massachusetts Turnpike in conjunction with the construction of Route 2.

7. In the city of Leominster approximately nine tenths of an acre on the west side of Granite Street and south of the existing Route 2 owned by the city of Leominster and used for water reservoir purposes and the protection of water resources to be used for the relocation of Granite Street in conjunction with the construction of Route 2.

8. In the city of Leominster, approximately one tenth of an acre on the east side of Granite Street and south of the existing Route 2 owned by the city of Leominster and used for the protection of water resources to be used for the construction of an access road in conjunction with the construction of Route 2.

Chap. 617. AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN LANDS OF THE COMMONWEALTH LOCATED IN THE TOWN OF WAREHAM TO THE CONTROL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR HIGHWAY PURPOSES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Subject to the provisions of chapter six hundred and ninety-three of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-five, as amended, the boards, officers and agencies having control of the lands of the commonwealth hereinafter described are hereby authorized and directed to transfer said lands, or such portions thereof as the department of public works may determine, to the control of said department, and said department is hereby authorized to divert said lands from their present public uses to highway use, as hereinafter provided.

Said lands to be so transferred and diverted are shown on a map entitled, "Commonwealth of Massachusetts Department of Public Works—Public Lands Needed for Highway Purposes, November 4, 1970", which said department is hereby directed to file in the office of the state secretary and which said secretary is hereby authorized to receive for filing, and are identified as follows:

For the construction of Route 25 in the town of Wareham.

1. In the town of Wareham, approximately two and five tenths acres of land owned by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Department of Education, used for agricultural experimental purposes.

2. In the town of Wareham, approximately six and five tenths acres of Union Pond, a great pond.

3. In the town of Wareham, approximately five and five tenths acres of Cedar Pond, a great pond.
