AN ACT EXTENDING THE TIME WITHIN WHICH CERTAIN SOLDIERS AND SAILORS AND THEIR WIVES, WIDOWS, FATHERS OR MOTHERS MAY FILE APPLICATIONS FOR ABATEMENT OR EXEMPTION OF TAXES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 534 of the acts of 1949 is hereby amended
2 by striking out section 3, as amended by chapter 301
3 of the acts of 1951, and inserting in place thereof the
4 following section:—

5 *Section 3.* Application for abatement or exemption,
6 as provided in sections one and two, of taxes levied
7 in the year nineteen hundred and fifty-one may be
8 made not later than October first, nineteen hundred
9 and fifty-two, notwithstanding any provision of law
10 to the contrary.
