AN ACT

Relative to the Reporting of Questions of Law by the
Superior Court.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows :—*

1 SECT. 1. Questions of law, whether arising upon
2 a trial or other proceeding before the superior court,
3 may be reported either before or after verdict for the
4 determination of the supreme judicial court ; and so
5 much of the case as is necessary for the understand-
6 ing of said questions shall be reported for that
7 purpose.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
