By Mr. O'Leary of Boston, petition of the Massachusetts State Chamber of Commerce, Inc., that a penalty be provided for the sale of motor vehicle master keys designated to fit the ignition switch of more than one vehicle. The Judiciary.

AN ACT PROHIBITING THE SALE OR OFFER OF SALE OF CERTAIN TYPES OF MOTOR VEHICLE KEYS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 No person may sell or offer to sell any motor vehicle master
2 key knowingly designed to fit the ignition switch on more than
3 one vehicle. A person who violates this act is guilty of a mis-
4 demeanor and upon conviction is punishable by a fine or not
5 less than twenty-five dollars nor more than two hundred dol-
6 lars.
