AN ACT RELATIVE TO APPEALS OF CERTAIN INCREASES IN OPERATING COSTS OF LONG TERM CARE FACILITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 36 of chapter 6A, as appearing in the
2 1986 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line
3 16, the word "thirty" and inserting in place thereof the word: —
4 fifteen.

1 SECTION 2. Paragraph 4(b) of section 2.14 of 114.2 Code of
2 Massachusetts Regulations is hereby amended by striking out the
3 following sentence: — Examples of such unusual and unforeseen
4 circumstances are loss of licensed beds, changes in level of care
5 and real estate tax increases.
