AN ACT RELATING TO AMNESTY FOR NORFOLK PRISON PROTESTORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 To restore to all of the individuals who received disciplinary
2 reports for participating in the peaceful protest at MCI-Norfolk
3 on May 13th and 14th, 1987 the same classification and
4 disciplinary status that each enjoyed prior to said protest, and to
5 rescind all statutory good time forfeitures imposed upon those
6 individuals by the Commissioner of Correction as a result of their
7 direct or indirect participation in said protest, and to further
8 rescind all reclassification to higher security, segregation, or
9 D.S.U. status imposed upon those individuals by the Department
10 of Correction as a result of their direct or indirect participation
11 in said protest.
