AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF SPECIAL ASSISTANT DISTRICT ATTORNEYS DURING A PERIOD OF CIVIL DISORDER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 14 of chapter 12 of the General Laws, is hereby
2 amended by adding at the end thereof the following para-
3 graph:—

4 During a period of civil disorder, the district attorneys of the
5 several counties may appoint such numbers of special assistant
6 district attorneys as may in their judgment be needed to deal
7 with booking, arraignment and trial procedures in the district
8 or municipal courts within their districts. Such special assistant
9 district attorneys may be appointed with or without compensa-
10 tion. If appointed with compensation, the compensation shall
11 be subject to approval by the county commissioners.

The following is a copy of the report of the committee on the subject of the proposed amendment to the constitution of the State of New York, as passed by the Senate on the 10th day of March, 1892.
