AN ACT PROVIDING THAT CERTAIN COURTS MAY DESIGNATE ONE ASSISTANT CHIEF PROBATION OFFICER FOR EVERY FIVE PROBATION OFFICERS THEREIN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The first paragraph of section 83 of chapter 276 of the Gen-
2 eral Laws is hereby amended by striking out the second
3 sentence, as amended by chapter 272 of the acts of 1957, and
4 further amended by chapter 675 of the acts of 1965, and
5 inserting in place thereof the following sentence:—In a
6 probation office of any court, other than the municipal court
7 of the city of Boston, having two or more probation officers,
8 one may be designated as chief probation officer; in any such
9 probation office having five or more probation officers, for
10 each five such officers, one may be designated as assistant
11 chief probation officer; and in any such probation office
12 having three or more assistant chief probation officers, one
13 may be designated first assistant chief probation officer.
