## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirty-Five.

An Act relative to the Fixing of Salaries of Members of the Police and Fire Departments of the City of Cambridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Salaries of the members of the police  
2 and fire departments of the city of Cambridge shall  
3 be fixed by ordinance, the provisions of any special  
4 or other law to the contrary notwithstanding.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its
