Hickey for increasing the salaries of the clerks and assistant clerks of the Superior Court for civil business and the Superior Court for criminal business in Suffolk County and of the clerks and assistant clerks of courts of various counties. AN ACT INCREASING THE SALARIES OF THE CLERKS AND ASSISTANT CLERKS OF THE SUPERIOR COURT FOR CIVIL BUSINESS AND THE SUPERIOR COURT FOR CRIMINAL BUSINESS IN THE COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, AND THE CLERKS AND ASSISTANT CLERKS OF COURTS OF THE VARIOUS COUNTIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 94 of chapter 221 of the General Laws,
2 as most recently amended by chapter 625 of the acts of 1967,
3 is hereby further amended by striking out all after the
4 caption SUPERIOR COURT FOR CRIMINAL BUSINESS IN THE
5 COUNTY OF SUFFOLK, and inserting in place thereof the
6 following:—

7 Clerk.—Twenty-two thousand eight hundred and thirty-
8 three dollars.

9 First Assistant Clerk (so designated by the clerk).—A sum
10 equivalent to seventy-five per cent of the salary of the
11 clerk.

12 All other Assistant Clerks.—A sum equivalent to sixty per
13 cent of the salary of the clerk.

14 SUPERIOR COURT FOR CIVIL BUSINESS IN THE COUNTY OF
15 SUFFOLK.

16 Clerk.—Twenty-two thousand eight hundred and thirty-
17 three dollars.

18 First Assistant Clerk (so designated by the justices of said
19 court).—A sum equivalent to eighty per cent of the salary of
20 the clerk.

21 Assistant clerk appointed to perform the duties of clerk
22 pertaining to equity proceedings in said court and designated
23 to act as clerk of said court when sitting in Boston for the
24 hearing of causes from any other county—a sum equivalent
25 to eighty per cent of the salary of the clerk, of which the sum
26 of twenty-five hundred dollars shall be paid by the com-
27 monwealth.

28 All other Assistant Clerks.—A sum equivalent to sixty per
29 cent of the salary of the clerk.

30 In all other counties, the salaries of the clerks of the courts
31 shall be as follows:—

32 Middlesex—Twenty-two thousand eight hundred and
33 thirty-three dollars.

34 Essex—Twenty-one thousand three hundred and fifteen
35 dollars.

36 Worcester—Twenty-one thousand three hundred and
37 fifteen dollars.

38 Hampden—Nineteen thousand seven hundred and ninety-
39 seven dollars.

40 Bristol—Nineteen thousand seven hundred and ninety-
41 seven dollars.

42 Norfolk—Eighteen thousand two hundred and seventy-
43 nine dollars.

44 Plymouth—Sixteen thousand seven hundred and sixty-one
45 dollars.

46 Berkshire—Thirteen thousand seven hundred and twenty-
47 five dollars.

48 Hampshire—Twelve thousand two hundred and five
49 dollars.

50 Barnstable—Twelve thousand two hundred and five
51 dollars.

52 Franklin—Twelve thousand two hundred and five
53 dollars.

54 Dukes—Six thousand one hundred and thirty-five
55 dollars.

56 Nantucket—Six thousand one hundred and thirty-five
57 dollars.

58 In all counties other than Suffolk, the assistant clerk shall
59 receive a sum equivalent to seventy-five per cent of the salary
60 of the clerk, the second assistant clerk shall receive a sum
61 equivalent to sixty per cent of the salary of the clerk, and all
62 other assistant clerks shall receive a sum equivalent to fifty-
63 five per cent of the salary of the clerk.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
