1 *Resolved*, That a special commission, to consist of two mem-
2 bers of the senate, four members of the house of representatives,
3 and two persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby es-
4 tablished for the purpose of making an investigation and study
5 relative to the ratio of non-white persons employed by the
6 commonwealth to that of Caucasian persons employed by the
7 commonwealth.
