### AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE STATE SECRETARY TO AUTHORIZE THE SOLEMNIZATION OF A CERTAIN MARRIAGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of section thirty-nine of chapter  
2 two hundred and seven of the General Laws, the state secretary  
3 may authorize in the manner set forth under said section thirty-  
4 nine, the solemnization of a marriage in the town of Eastham,  
5 by the Honorable W. James O'Neill, who is a judge of the district  
6 court department of the trial court, Barnstable division, on May  
7 sixth, nineteen hundred and ninety, between Pamela V. Marshall  
8 and Howard M. Pavlofsky, both of the town of Orleans, and the  
9 state secretary shall issue to said Honorable W. James O'Neill in  
10 his capacity as aforesaid a certificate of such authorization.
