The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Four.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE HOLDING OF CERTAIN TOWN ELECTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 That any town that votes to adopt section 9B may, under
- 2 Clause A, hold town elections once every two years, or under
- 3 Clause B, hold town elections every four years.
- 4 During odd numbered years during the months of March,
- 5 April, May, September, October or November, a choice of one
- 6 of these months. The town may vote to select the day of holding
- 7 the elections. The town shall adopt Clause A or Clause B in a
- 8 separate article of section 9B of chapter 39.
