Bill accompanying the petition of Frederick A. Gould for legislation to establish his salary as assistant paying teller in the department of the Treasurer and Receiver General. Public Service. January 14.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ten.

AN ACT

To establish the Salary of the Assistant Paying Teller in the Office of the Treasurer and Receiver General.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The salary of the assistant paying teller in
2 the office of the treasurer and receiver general shall be
3 fifteen hundred dollars per annum, the same to be allowed
4 and paid from the first day of January, nineteen hundred
5 and ten.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
