DECISION

This was a hearing concerning alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Ch.138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (1 count).

The licensee stipulated to the facts of the investigator's report which stated that an underage operative, working under the supervision of A.B.C.C. investigators, ordered and was served a Bud Light. The youth, whose date of birth is 11/24/90, was not asked for ID.

The licensee has owned the establishment for 4 years and has not had any previous violations.

Based on the evidence, the Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission finds that the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: Ch.138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (1 count) and, therefore, **suspends the license for a period of 3 days.**
