### AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REPORTING REQUIREMENTS OF THE ADVISORY BOARD ON LEGISLATIVE AND CONSTITUTIONAL COMPENSATION.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 162 of Chapter 6 of the General Laws as  
2 most recently amended by Chapter 1172 of the Acts of 1973 is  
3 hereby further amended by striking out in the second sentence the  
4 phrase "in each odd numbered year" and inserting in place thereof  
5 the following word: — "annually".

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
