AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE USE OF CERTAIN PERIODS OF LEAVE OF ABSENCE OF BEATRICE E. PIERCE OF DRACUT AS CREDITABLE SERVICE FOR RETIREMENT PURPOSES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Beatrice E. Pierce of Dracut, an employee of the employ-  
2 ment security division of the commonwealth and a member  
3 of the state retirement system, shall be entitled to count  
4 as creditable service in said system the period from July  
5 eighteen or August twenty-fourth, nineteen hundred and  
6 forty-five depending on acceptance of terminal leave (mili-  
7 tary) as "active service", to June eleven, nineteen hundred  
8 and forty-seven during which period she was absent on  
9 leave under a readjustment program authorized by law, as  
10 a returning veteran; provided, that said Beatrice E. Pierce  
11 shall deposit in the annuity savings fund of said system such  
12 amount as the state retirement board may determine as being  
13 equal to that which she would have paid into said fund had  
14 her service not been so interrupted by said leave with regular  
15 interest thereon.
