AN ACT TO FURTHER THE ABILITY OF PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITIES TO PROVIDE FOR THE SAFETY AND WELL-BEING OF THEIR TENANTS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 167 of Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by inserting at the end of the first paragraph the following: —
- 3 “Criminal justice agencies” shall include housing authorities,
- 4 established pursuant to Chapter 121B of the General Laws, but
- 5 only with respect to such authorities’ public safety and security
- 6 functions and such authorities’ cause eviction function, and as to
- 7 such cause eviction function only as to events which could
- 8 currently provide a basis for action to terminate tenancies for
- 9 those causes set forth in the sixth sentence of the sixth paragraph
- 10 of section 32 of Chapter 121B of the General Laws or in section 19
- 11 of Chapter 139 of the General Laws.
