AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE SOUTH SHORE TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT SHALL NOT BECOME PART OF THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT AUTHORITY NOR BE LIABLE FOR ANY PART OF THE DEFICIT THEREOF.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 452 of the acts of 1961 is hereby amended by adding  
2 at the end the following section: —

3 *Section 27.* Notwithstanding any other provisions of this act  
4 or any other provisions of the General Laws to the contrary the  
5 district created hereunder shall not become a part of the Metro-  
6 politan Transit Authority as established under chapter five hun-  
7 dred and forty-four of the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-  
8 seven, nor shall any city or town of the district be liable for any  
9 of the debts, deficits, deficiencies or obligations of the said  
10 Metropolitan Transit Authority as reported to the state treas-  
11 urer by the trustees of the Metropolitan Transit Authority under  
12 and in accordance with chapter five hundred and forty-four of  
13 the acts of nineteen hundred and forty-seven, as amended.
