Frost that provisions be made to authorize and direct the Massachusetts Highway Department to design and construct a class one bikeway within the route 146 reconstruction project. Transportation.

RESOLVE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MASSACHUSETTS HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT TO DESIGN AND CONSTRUCT A CLASS ONE BIKEWAY WITHIN THE ROUTE 146 RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 *Resolved*, That the Massachusetts Highway Department is hereby
2 authorized and directed to design and construct the proposed Black-
3 stone River Bikeway from the planned Northern Gateway Visitors
4 Center, the former Rome Building, located in the city of Worcester
5 in the Kane "A" section of the Route 146 Reconstruction Project, as
6 a Class One Bikeway in an alignment as close as feasible to the
7 route of the Blackstone River. Said department is prohibited from
8 utilizing the reconstructed Ballard Street for bikeway purposes and
9 shall revise the bikeway plan accordingly.
