AN ACT TO PROVIDE FURTHER DISCLOSURE OF THE SOURCES OF POLITICAL CONTRIBUTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of Chapter 55, appearing in Section 1 of Chapter
2 1173 of the Acts of 1973, is hereby further amended by strik-
3 ing out in clause (1) and clause (2) in each instance, the
4 words "and residential address" and inserting in place there-
5 of, in each instance, the words: — residential address, oc-
6 cupation, and principal place of business; and by striking out
7 in clause (5) and clause (6) thereof, in each instance, the
8 words "and address" and inserting in place thereof, in each
9 instance, the words: — address, occupation, and principal
10 place of business.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE ORGANIZATION OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA
POLICE DEPARTMENT

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Congress
assembled, on the 17th day of July, 1924, as follows:

Section 2 of Chapter 15, approved in Section 1 of Chapter
1117 of the Acts of 1917, is hereby further amended by adding
therein the following: (1) and (2) in each instance, the
words "and technical advice" and therein in the
