An Act to require All Buildings used as Hospitals to  
be of Fireproof Construction.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter one hundred and forty-eight of the Gen-  
2 eral Laws is hereby amended by inserting after sec-  
3 tion nine the following new section:—

4 *Section 9A.* Any building used in whole or in  
5 part as a hospital shall be built of fireproof con-  
6 struction and shall be equipped with automatic  
7 sprinklers.
