

**Chap. 615.** AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS RELOCATE THE MONUMENT AT THE SITE OF THE MYLES GARRISON HOUSE, SO CALLED, IN THE TOWN OF SWANSEA.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. The department of public works is hereby authorized and directed to relocate the monument maintained by it at the site of the Myles Garrison House, so called, in the town of Swansea to a suitable location selected by said town.

SECTION 2. The town of Swansea is hereby authorized to accept said monument from the commonwealth for relocation on such a site.

SECTION 3. Chapter one hundred and twenty-six of the acts of nineteen hundred and thirty-four is hereby repealed.

**Chap. 616.** AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSIONER OF CORRECTION TO TRANSFER AND CONVEY CERTAIN LAND TO THE TOWN OF SHERBORN.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

The commissioner of correction, acting for and on behalf of the commonwealth, is hereby authorized to transfer and convey to the town of Sherborn to be used for conservation purposes for a consideration of one dollar, by a deed approved as to form by the attorney general, all the right, title and interest of the commonwealth in and to the following parcels of land of the commonwealth located in said town, which land is under the control of the Massachusetts Correctional Institution, Framingham, and shown on a plan entitled "Massachusetts Department of Correction, Framingham, Mass., Massachusetts Correctional Institution Framingham, Land Survey, Scale 1 inch = 300 feet, Moriece and Gary, Inc., Site Planners, Cambridge, Mass., September, 1963".

*Parcel 1:* Located on the easterly side of Perry Street and the westerly side of Prospect Street, as appearing on said plan, and described thereon as "17.5 ± acres, Johnson, 1894".

*Parcel 2:* Located on the westerly side of Perry Street and the northerly side of Brush Hill Road, as appearing on said plan, and described thereon as "36.5 ± acres Johnson, 1894".

*Parcel 3:* Located on the southerly side of Brush Hill Road, as appearing on said plan, and described thereon as 39 ± acres, Johnson, 1894; provided, however, that all land presently being used for cemetery purposes by said Institution in parcels 1 and 2 shall be retained by the commonwealth and shall not be conveyed to the Town of Sherborn.

**Chap. 617.** AN ACT REQUIRING SCHOOL DEPARTMENTS OF CITIES AND TOWNS TO PAY THE COST OF TRANSPORTING MENTALLY RETARDED PERSONS TO DAY PROGRAMS FOR EDUCATION, HABILITATION OR CARE OPERATED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF MENTAL HEALTH AND PROVIDING THAT THE STATE REIMBURSE CITIES AND TOWNS FOR SAID COSTS.

*Be it enacted, etc., as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 29B of chapter 69 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence, added by section 1 of chapter
